



# LOGHAN HAT

**A KNITS N KNACKS PATTERN  
DESIGNED BY CINDY WILLIAMS**

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#### Materials:

- Bernat Premium worsted weight yarn  
(with one full ball you should get approx 2.75 hats)
- 6mm (US 10) needles
- Darning needle
- Waste yarn in a different color
- Faux fur pom-pom

#### Gauge:

- A 5" square garter stitch should be 18 sts by 34 rows. You can also check your gauge after the first 12 rows.
- The finished rectangle before grafting should be approx 13" wide and 15.5" tall.



#### Baby size hack!

For 6-18m CO 38 sts and work for 96 rows

The Logan Hat is a beautiful yet simple hat to knit. Excellent for adventurous beginners and perfect for experienced knitters who want to relax with some mindless knitting. With its super stretchy garter stitch it will fit from a 2 year old all the way to an adult and can be worn super slouchy or with no slouch at all just by adjusting the fold of the brim!

#### Pattern:

- Cast on 44sts with scrap yarn, you must use a provisional cast on. (If you click this link { <https://youtu.be/bLjU4OZNtaY> } it will direct you to YouTube and a lovely lady will show you how to cast on (she also shows you how to do the kitchener stitch later on in the video, which you will need at the end of this pattern. Like and subscribe if you found it helpful!)
- Using your main yarn knit every stitch across. You will be knitting every row for a total of 106 rows or 53 garter ridge bumps on one side of the work.
- Cut your yarn leaving a LONG tail about 3 feet long
- At this point you can go back to the video for help to do the kitchener stitch, if done properly this hat will look practically seamless!
- Now that you finished the kitchener graft you will flip the hat inside out, knot the remaining yarn from the graft securely in place on the top edge of the hat and then work the running stitch (An easy way to do this is to run your yarn through the end of every garter bump on one side) with your darning needle, all around the top edge of the Logan hat and pull to cinch it up. Knot the yarn and go around again if needed
- Weave in all remaining ends, flip it right side out and attach you favorite pom-pom.
